BULK WASTE

Household items that are too large to fit in the provided collection cart(s). Extra garbage bags are not considered bulk waste.

YARD WASTE

Leaves, grass trimming, brush, wood chips, and shrub and tree trimmings. NO roots or stumps larger than six inches wide!

Yard waste must be placed in a separate container, bagged or tied in bundles that are less than six feet in length and less than 50 lbs. per bundle, bag or container. Only 2 cubic yards of bulk or yard waste per residence will be picked up on your scheduled day. Do not put bulk or yard waste in the blue or green carts. Contact Waste Connections to schedule pickup of tires and white goods (refrigerators, ranges, washers, dryers, water heaters, dishwashers, and other similar appliances).
