A copy of the plans or a scale drawing of the proposed construction showing all dimensions include square footage, setback locations, and location of septic system and drain field must be attached to this application. Any permit request missing this information will not be accepted until completed. If any changes are made to these plans, you must apply for a new permit.

PLEASE NOTE: Weather conditions may require removal of sunshade. Sunshades may not become unsightly, torn, or in any form of disrepair. Homeowner may be required to replace sunshade if deemed necessary.

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Standards

All permits for a sunshade, pergola, or gazebo must be submitted to the Spring Lake Property Association permit chairperson. Any request outside the standards will be submitted by permit chairperson to Spring Lake Property Association Board of Directors for review.

To assist you in obtaining a permit to install a sunshade, pergola, or gazebo of any kind, the Board of Directors of the Spring Property Association has compiled the following standards in order to remain within the Spring Lake Property Association deed restrictions and Florida Statutes.

The following standards must be observed along with all Highlands County Building Standards.

No tents and no accessory or temporary building or structures shall be erected without the written consent of the subdivider or Spring Lake Property Association.

No building or structure of any kind, including additions, alterations, pools, fences, walls, patios, terraces or barbecue pits shall be erected or altered until the plans and specifications, location, and plot plan thereof, in detail and to scale, shall have been submitted to and approved by the subdivider or Spring Lake Property Association in writing before any construction has begun.


